

1915(i) Home & Community Based Services

What is 1915(i)?

The North Dakota Medicaid 1915(i) State Plan Amendment allows North Dakota Medicaid to pay for additional home and community-based services to support individuals with behavioral health conditions.

Serving in the following Counties: Burleigh (Bismarck) • Morton (Mandan) • Sioux (Ft. Yates) • Cass (Fargo) • Grand Forks • Richland (Wahpeton)

Eligible individuals will work with a Care Coordinator to develop an individualized plan of services, which may include the following:

- 1. Care Coordination
- 2. Non-Medical Transportation
- 3. Supported Education
- 4. Supported Employment
- 5. Housing Support
- 6. Family Peer Support
- 7. Peer Support

For individuals to be eligible to receive services reimbursed through the 1915(i), individuals must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Age 0+; and
- 2. Enrolled in ND Medicaid or Medicaid Expansion; and
- **3.** Have a household income at or below 150% of Federal Poverty Level; and
- 4. Receive a WHODAS score of 25 or above, and
- 5. Reside in and will receive services in a settling meeting the federal home and community-based setting requirements; and
- **6.** Have a diagnosis of substance use disorder, mental illness, or brain injury
